

Prof. G.S. Bajpai made a presentation before the Joint Parliamentary Committee on three significant Bills on 7 January 2026



Professor G.S. Bajpai, Vice Chancellor NLU Delhi was invited to make a presentation on the provisos of the three bills namely The Constitution (One Hundred and Thirtieth Amendment) Bill, 2025; The Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation (Amendment) Bill, 2025; and The Government Of Union Territories (Amendment) Bill, 2025 before the Joint Parliamentary Committee at Lok Sabha Secretariat on 7 January 2026.

In his presentation, Prof. G.S. Bajpai discussed and presented his views on various signification provisos of the above bill.

The Govt. of India has constituted 'The Joint Parliamentary Committee (JPC)' to examine 'The Constitution (One Hundred and Thirtieth Amendment) Bill, 2025; The Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation (Amendment) Bill, 2025; and The Government Of Union Territories (Amendment) Bill, 2025. The Committee consists of 31 Members (21 Lok Sabha Members and 10 Rajya Sabha Members) and is Chaired by Ms. Aparajita Sarangi, Member Lok Sabha.

The three Bills, introduced on the last day of the Monsoon Session on August 20, 2025 seek automatic removal of the Prime Minister, Chief Ministers, and Ministers if they are detained for thirty days on serious charges.
